Dear Parents, Guardians and Carers,

In the first full week back after the summer break, lessons and activities have been in full swing and pupils and staff are back into a settled and energetic routine. We have seen the return of Wednesday Afternoon activities and the excitement of pupils engaged in the wide range of activities on offer, whether out on the beaches surfing, or back at school print making and bridge building. There has been a wonderful performance of our Edinburgh Fringe play (which received glowing reviews in the Scottish press), the first Sunday service for new Choristers, an Art trip to soak in the scenery of Cape Cornwall and the start of this year's sports fixtures in rugby, hockey, golf and netball.

It was a pleasure to welcome parents of Lower Sixth and new 1st to 3rd Year pupils this week into our community at two welcome evenings and to explain all the support on offer. Staff really enjoyed the opportunity to meet with you. The pastoral team has been delighted with how our new pupils have been settling in. They have got stuck into lessons and activities with gusto and have helped each other out when, just occasionally, they may have struggled to find their way around School.

At our beginning of year assembly, I encouraged all pupils to seek help when they need it. There is a superb pastoral team of tutors, Heads of Year, School nurses and counsellors, not to mention our new Chaplain, Rev Helen and our team of trained Sixth Form ACHE counsellors. We have expanded our counselling team and capacity this academic year, which means that this free service will have shorter waiting times and be able to support pupils who need a more dedicated space to talk, more quickly. Reaching out for help certainly takes courage and I reminded pupils that we are here for everyone – nothing is too much trouble to listen to and share.

Finally, we look forward to celebrating the success of pupils in all their endeavours this year with the publicity those achievements deserve. Our new Positive Behaviour and Values Policy has increased the number of certificates awarded for merits and these will be awarded publicly in Head of Year Assemblies every fortnight. There is a swifter pathway to public reward and recognition, every 15 merits until pupils reach 75, first with an appropriately Cornish "Tin Award", leading through Gold Award right up to Coronation Award for 150 merits in a year. Next week, we will have our first of the new Values Awards given to one pupil per year group, every fortnight, for those who have shown great character and are living the School values. It should generate some fantastic stories of spirit and achievement.

I hope that you all enjoy a great weekend.

New Parent Welcome Evening Recordings

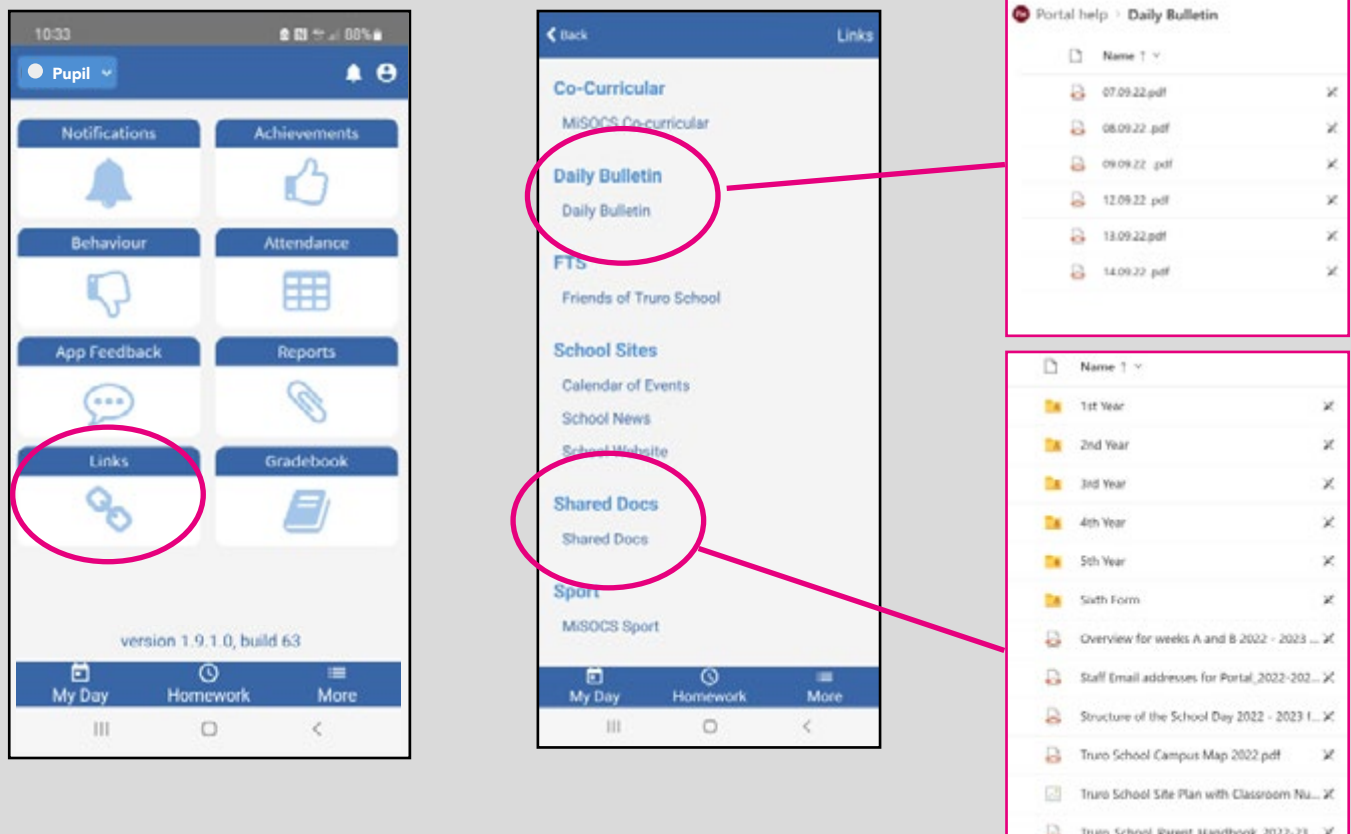

Introducing the New Head Girl and Head Boy Team

Congratulations to our new Head Girl and Head Boy Team who were appointed at the end of last year. We caught up with them to find out more about their journeys through Truro School and what they are hoping to achieve this year.

Tell us about your time at Truro School, what A-Levels are you studying and why did you choose Truro School Sixth Form?

Head Boy Oliver is studying A-level Physics, Chemistry, Maths and Further Maths. Having played Jean Val Jean in last year's school production of Les Miserables, it was the opportunities beyond the curriculum that appealed to him. "I started in the 1st Year and chose to stay on for Sixth Form because of all the extra-curricular activities such as drama and music, which I can enjoy alongside my A-level subjects."

Head Girl Tara is studying Spanish, Geography, RS and EPQ and chose Truro School Sixth Form because of the strong sense of community she feels at Truro School. "On a social and personal level, this is where I wanted to take the most significant exams of my life so far." Tara is also training part-time with the British sailing team. She competed at the European Championships last year and this year will compete in the Nationals.

Deputy Head Girl Lexi, who has been at Truro School since Nursery is studying Maths, Physics, Economics and Further Maths. "I wanted to stay here because of the culture and the friendly atmosphere. I already know many of my teachers." Lexi is a fencer and currently competes in both the U20 and senior GB Fencing teams. Her next big event will be the World Championships in Saudi Arabia in April 2024.

Deputy Head Boy Tom, Joined Truro School Prep in Year 6. He is taking A-level Geology, Maths and Chemistry and has enjoyed spending time in these departments throughout his GCSEs. "I like the holistic approach to teaching here. The elective MOOCs (massive open online courses) have been brilliant and the smaller class sizes mean I get to know my teachers; having lively discussions with them about my subjects is great."

What made you apply for the Head Boy and Head Girl positions, and is there anything in particular you would like to achieve this year?

Both Oliver and Tara were inspired to apply for their positions by previous Head Boys and Head Girls. Oliver is keen to nurture our value of courage through the school saying "Always aim high; things are often more achievable than you think." All four members of this dynamic team are very keen to engage with younger pupils from across the school, who they hope will find them approachable and easy to talk to.

Tom applied to the team because "I wanted to prove myself wrong, and it was good practice for applying for jobs in future."

The Head Girl and Head Boy team, who meet for breakfast with the Head once a week to discuss ideas, are adept at balancing the demands of A-Levels and their extra and co-curricular demands. All of them are making the most of Truro School's outstanding Sixth Form Diploma and are looking forward to the additional challenges and opportunities presented by these roles. They hope to make a meaningful contribution during their tenure and we look forward to sharing more about how they get on.

Exploring Last Year's Harvest

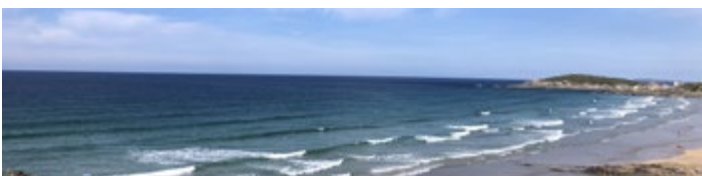
Our first gardening session of the term was a vibrant affair, where 1st and 2nd Years came together to explore last year's harvest and brainstorm our goals for this season.

- Inspiring Talks and Workshops



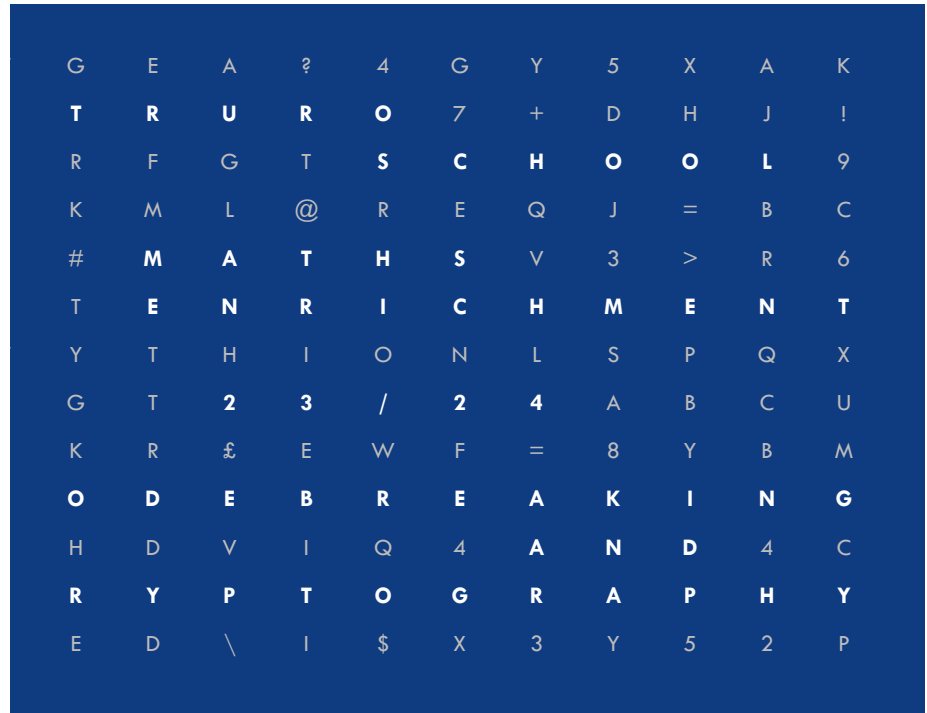
