Drivers Look Both Ways!

Since the one way circuit was introduced the majority of traffic leaves the School via the Snake onto Trennick Lane but there are still some vehicles which legitimately drive down Trennick Lane. We would like to take this opportunity to remind you to take care when exiting from the Snake as there may be vehicles coming down Trennick Lane and we have now installed a sign at the bottom of the Snake reminding drivers to look both ways.
