Tuesday 10 April: 11:30am-2pm - Seniors. Under 16, Lower Sixth and Upper Sixth

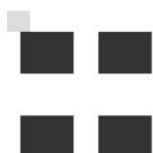
The early morning sessions will continue during the summer term and the different squads will be notified at the beginning of the summer term.
