Dear Parents, Carers and Guardians

It has been a super start to term. My thanks to you all who have supported that start; to you, to our staff, and especially to the pupils. It was lovely, on Wednesday, to pause before my Assembly and listen to the sound of children chatting and catching up with each other after the break. It was the very happy sound of both shared stories of the holiday, and genuine excitement for being back in School, with each other, and us.

Over the break many staff have worked hard to refurbish or improve aspects of the site, often in areas unseen by pupils, and I also thank all who were involved in School trips and expeditions too. The staff began term on Monday. It was great to welcome back Mr Whatley to his Economics and Business team, and Mr Jones to the languages team. We also welcomed Mrs Whomersley, Mrs Knight and Mr Harrison to the Music Department.

The two days of staff time were devoted to training, and pastoral and educational discussion. As well as wider training around safeguarding and inclusion, best practice sessions were led by a wide range of staff as part of our ongoing commitment to the pursuit of quality and consistency in all we do. This is also the term of the year when I and my team draw themes together to establish next year's Schoolwide priorities. Input into that thinking comes from staff, from you via the cycle of surveys across the year (my thanks to those year group parents who have completed them already and in advance to those upcoming this term), and, crucially, from the pupils, whose views we canvas in a variety of ways.

In front of us all now, however, is a Summer term of opportunity and activity. For our examination year groups, all our support is in place, and familiarisation with the venues to be used and any other exam routines that are dissimilar to mocks will happen before exams begin. There is much more to look forward to as well, culturally and educationally, across a term that will culminate in our third annual Truro School Festival.

In my start of term Assembly I returned the School to the theme of Courage, our School value for this academic year. I commended the pupils for the multitude of examples across the year, the most important of which are often not public, or dramatic, but make a real difference to individuals and their, or a peers', confidence, or sense of belonging within our community. I reminded the pupils to celebrate that there is no one way to show courage, and that they and we are all therefore capable of being courageous in our own ways, which gives me real hope and optimism for the term and the future ahead.

Thank you all for your support as we, together, this term, champion your children's wellbeing, growth and ambitions, through the joys and challenges of the term ahead.
